MODULE 10: CHANGE SETTING

The ASIE Model of CIDS is a flexible instructional design tool. You may choose minimum features/items or add optional items to design your instructional planning to cater to your needs. Most of the items are customizable to formulate the instructional activities.

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CHANGE SETTINGS (optional – advance level)

(Allows customization of items by users)

Change Settings – changing the arrangement or adding new items to existing aspects of the ASIE model

Arrangement/addition of items can be made to each of the aspects found in Component (1) **Analyze,** and Component (2) **Strategize**.

The default arrangement/items can be displayed again by pressing the Reset button.
