INTRODUCTION

The realigned document for Standard-based Primary School Curriculum (3rd edition) is part of MoE's commitment to enhance the effectiveness of curriculum implementation. This realigned curriculum document for Level I Primary School English Language involves rearranging the Learning Standards for each of the four language skills as well as combining certain Learning Standards from both the receptive skills component (Listening and Reading) and the productive skills component (Speaking and Writing) in order to reinforce pupils' understanding in learning language skills.

This realigned document provides teachers with an alternative to the existing Standards-Based Curriculum and Assessment Document in teaching English Language to Level I pupils. Any of these documents can be used together with the Guide Module (MOBIM) 1.0 rolled out in August 2023 as well as the existing Scheme of Work.

CONTENT ORGANISATION

This realigned document showcases features such as:

- Learning Standards for each of the language skills i.e.
 Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing are rearranged in order for similar skills to be taught back to back;
- ii) Learning Standards are grouped into clusters which may comprise two or more learning standards from a set of receptive skills or a set of productive skills; and
- iii) the use of a lesson cycle may span two periods of a lesson or the entire week depending on pupils' ability.

The content of this realigned document is arranged according to three columns i.e. Content Standard, Learning Standard and Notes. The numbered Content Standards and Learning Standards remain as they are in the existing Standards-Based Curriculum and Assessment Document. The Note column introduced in this realigned document contains details and intention of a particular cluster of learning standards. The column also adds guides for teachers to implement better teaching and learning.

CLASSROOM ASSESSMENT

In this realigned document, classroom assessment still involves the process of collecting information about pupils' progress in the classroom. The on-going assessment is planned, implemented and reported by respective teachers. This process is ongoing to enable teachers to determine the pupils' mastery level.

Performance Standards refer to the six levels of pupils' progress in the acquisition of the four language skills; Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. Teachers can diagnose the learning strengths and weaknesses, measure pupils' progress against the teaching and learning objectives, then review, restrategise and modify their teaching to enhance pupils' learning.

Specific Performance Standards Guides for Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing are provided in the Standards-Based Curriculum and Assessment Document. These Guides provide teachers with reference to gauge pupils' progress in the four language skills. Teachers can use the specific descriptors to determine the performance level of their pupils in the respective language skill.

It is hoped that this realigned document will serve as an avenue for teachers to exercise flexibility and suitability in teaching and learning process.

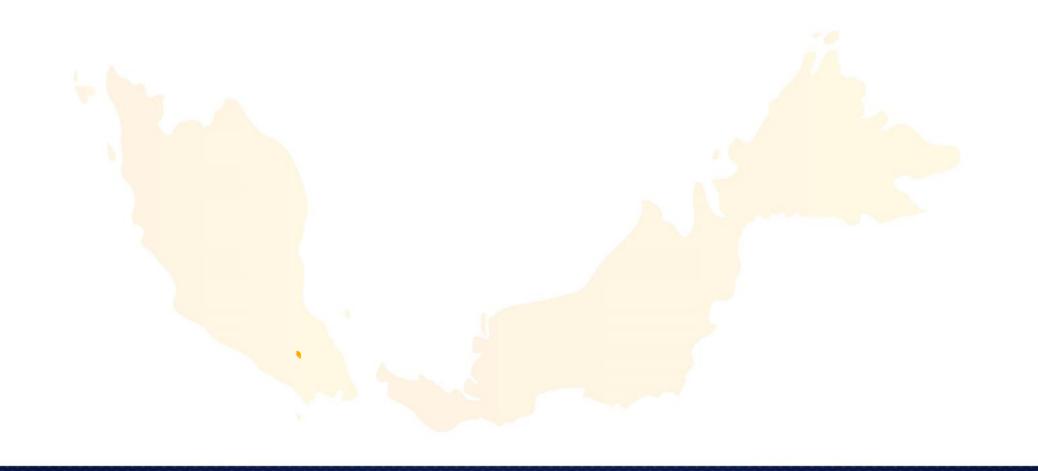
